The address was: Chip? Gate. His occupation on the census: cotton weaver. William died on 22 September 1868 in Huncoat.¹ He was buried on 25 September 1868 in St James'.¹

George appeared in the census in 1861 in Huncoat. The address was: Chip? Gate. His occupation on the census: Hoiser in wool and cotton. George died on 13 September 1861 in Huncoat.¹ He was buried on 16 September 1861 in St James'.¹

Ellen BENTLEY, daughter of Edward BENTLEY (-) and Martha WADE (-), was born on 16 March 1827 in Huncoat.¹ She was baptised on 1 July 1827 in St James'.¹ Ref#: 91.231.
